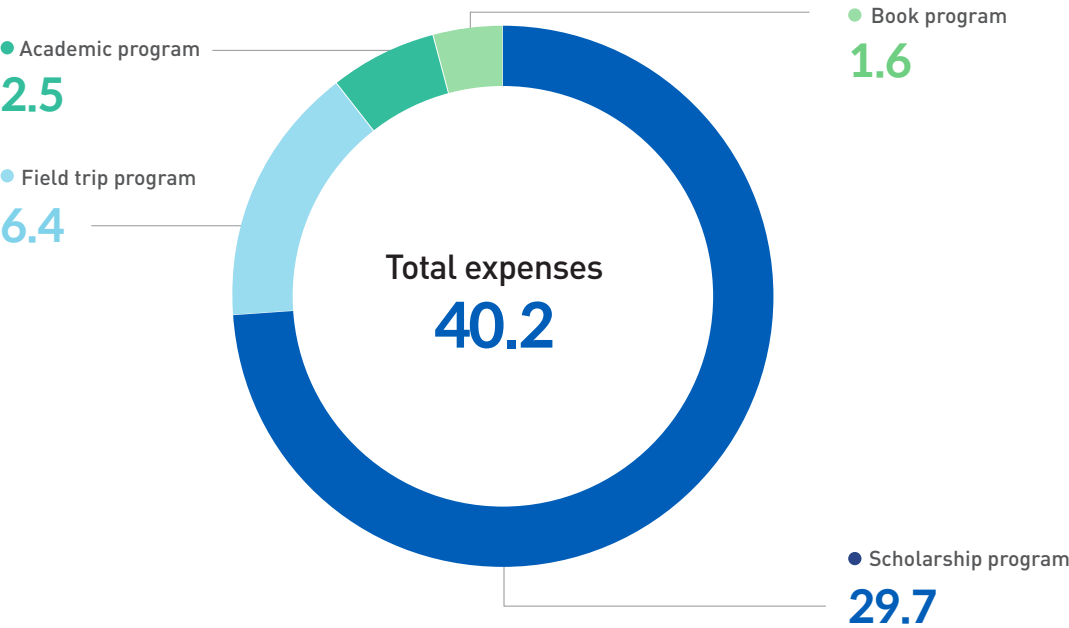
Scholarship program expenses by year

Since 1979, the Doosan Yonkang Foundation has been providing scholarships to university students who are striving to achieve their dreams despite challenging backgrounds by selecting them for a Doosan Yonkang scholarship. By helping them to focus on their studies without worrying about tuition costs, we are laying the foundation for them to grow into promising talents who will lead the future.

In 2024, a total of 42 Doosan Yonkang scholarship students were selected, and since the establishment of the foundation, a total of 3,562 university students have benefited from scholarships.

Eligibility

- Undergraduate students of Korean nationality enrolled in a four-year program at a domestic university
- Planning to enroll in the first semester of the second year
- Those who can attend both the first and second semester of the year after selection
- Have an overall semester GPA of 3.0/4.5 or higher
- Those who are within the 6th tier of the Korea Student Aid Foundation



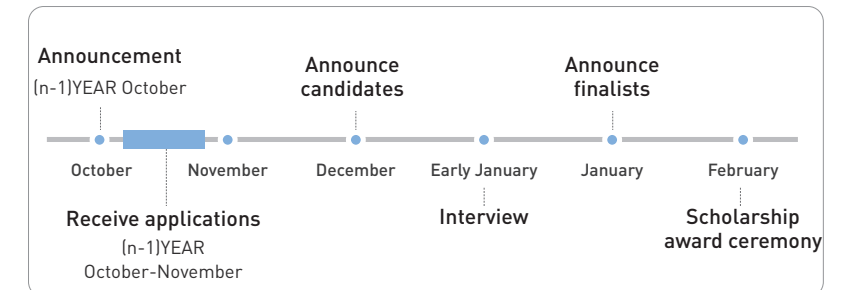

Since 1979, the Doosan Yonkang Foundation has been providing scholarship funding to high school students who excel academically despite challenging backgrounds by selecting them as Doosan Yonkang Scholarship students every year. The Doosan Yonkang Scholarship, which enables students to dedicate themselves to their studies in a stable manner, has been a great help to future talents who are doing their best under adverse conditions. In 2024, the program expanded from 80 to 84 high schools, including new schools in areas with high demand for scholarships. The Doosan Yonkang Foundation will continue to provide assistance to ensure that no student is forced to stop their studies due to financial difficulties.

Since 2006, we have been providing scholarships to elementary and middle school students from socially vulnerable groups who are living in difficult environments in their young age. Initially, the scholarship program was centered on students in the Seoul, but in 2018, we expanded the scope of the program to provide educational opportunities to more students nationwide. As of now, we have provided scholarships to a total of 3,682 students, which is more than just financial aid, but also a solid support that helps them to keep their hopes alive and pursue their dreams. The Doosan Yonkang Foundation will continue to care for and support underprivileged neighbors and future generations.

Established in 2023, the Doosan Yonkang Technical Talent High School Scholarship aims to contribute to the development of Korean industry by supporting outstanding technical talents. We have selected outstanding students from 18 high schools nationwide, including Meister High Schools in the fields of semiconductor, nuclear power, energy, robotics, and machinery, and have provided scholarships to a total of 108 students to date. In 2025, we plan to support two additional schools in the semiconductor field. In addition, we plan to create a collection of employment testimonials from scholarship recipients who have secured employment and share them with their schools and younger scholarship recipients, which is expected to contribute to revitalizing the employment ecosystem in various industries.



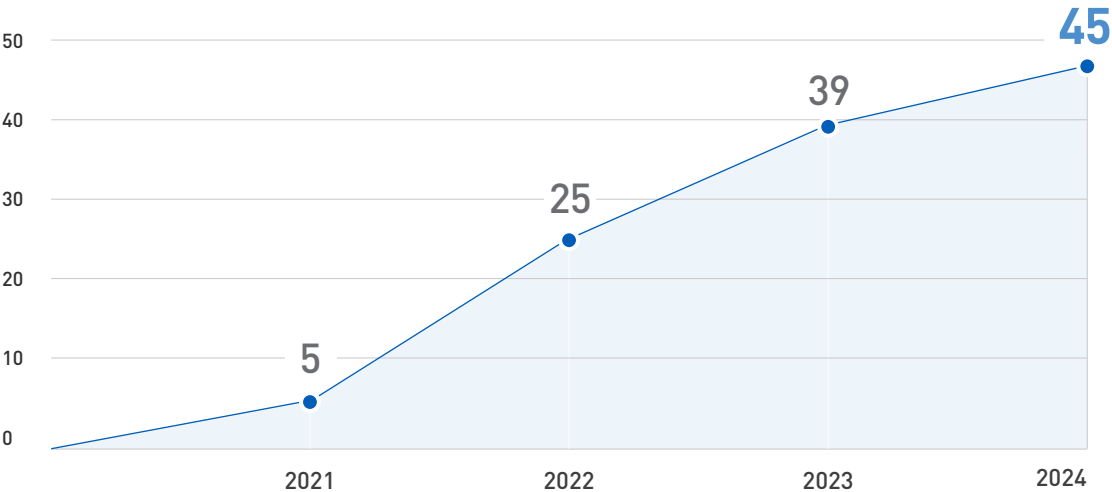

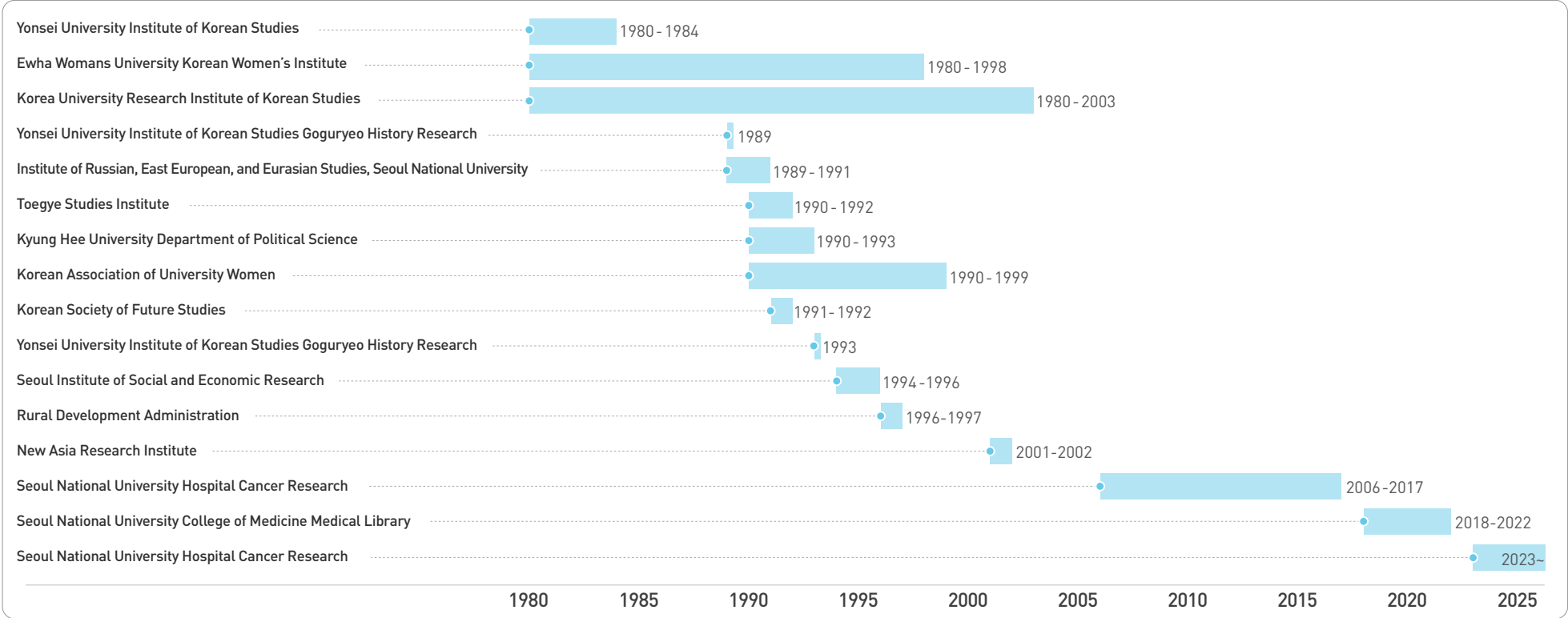
Since 1979, we have selected research institutes and professors affiliated with universities researching pure and basic disciplines and provided them with stable research grants so that they can focus on their research. Since 2006, we have provided a total of KRW 2 billion to Seoul National University Hospital to revitalize cancer research through 2030, and in 2018, we signed a KRW 1 billion support agreement to build a library at Seoul National University College of Medicine to improve the educational environment for future medical students.

Every year since 2007, all winners of the Science Teacher of the Year Award*, organized by the Ministry of Science and ICT and hosted by the Korea Foundation of Science and Creativity, have been given the opportunity to tour science-related facilities and sites in Korea and abroad. We have been donating books to elementary schools in Korea since 2006 to inspire creativity and wisdom in children through reading. By 2020, we had provided books to 414 elementary schools in remote areas of Korea, and since 2021, we have been providing books to elementary schools in small and medium-sized cities.

Rather than unilaterally selecting books, the project adopts a customized book support approach, whereby teachers at each school select the books they want their students to read based on a list of new and recommended books.

So far, we have donated more than 410,000 books to a total of 882 schools, and we will continue to give priority to elementary schools in small and medium-sized cities.
